

Employment by Program of Study:

- Of the 591 Tunxis Community College (TCC) graduates, 72% were employed in CT during the third quarter after graduation.
- The greatest number of employed graduates majored in Business, Management, Marketing & Related (150).
- The rate of employed graduates by program of study ranged from a high of 85% for Health Professions & Related Programs to a low of 55% for Homeland Sec., Law Enforcement, Fire & Related.
- 67% of employed graduates were women.
- About 53% of employed graduates worked in firms with 100 or more employees; 34% worked in firms with 500 or more employees.

Employment by Industry and Degree Program:

- About 24% of the 117 TCC graduates who majored in Liberal Arts & Sciences and were employed in the third quarter after graduation were working in the Retail Trade sector.
- 68% of the 66 graduates who majored in Health Professions & Related Programs and who were employed in the third quarter after graduation were working in the Health Care & Social Assistance sector.

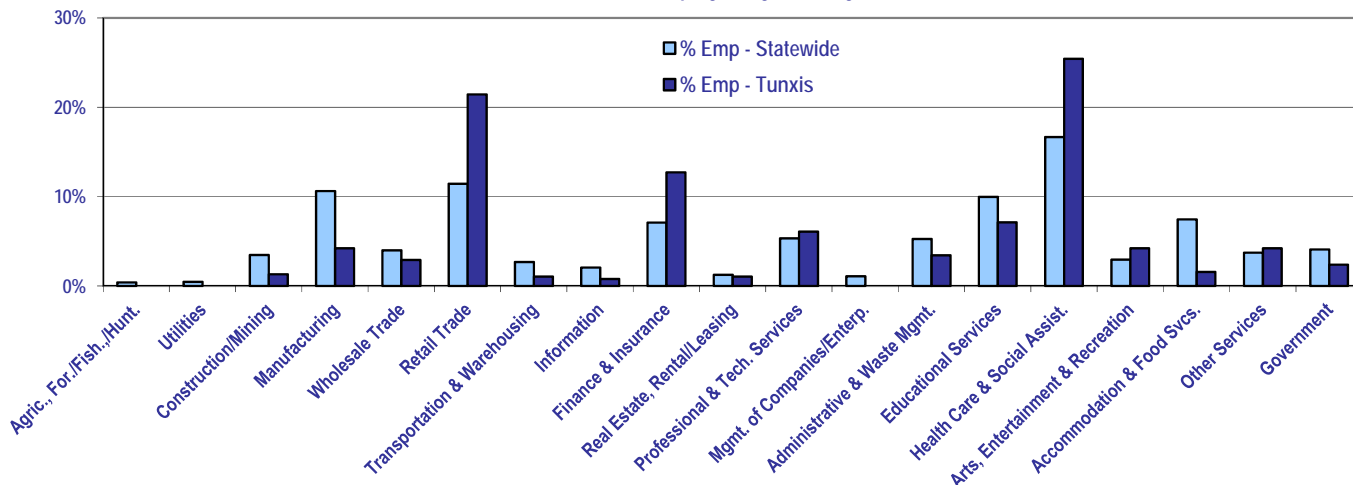

Employment and Earnings by Industry:

- Almost half (41%) of the TCC graduates employed in Connecticut during the third quarter after graduation were working in the Health Care & Social Assistance and Retail Trade sectors.
- The overall average quarterly earnings for graduates employed in the third quarter after graduation was \$7,288. Graduates working in Government had the highest average quarterly earnings (\$16,297).
- Compared to overall statewide employment, a greater percentage of TCC graduates were employed in the Health Care & Social Assistance, Finance & Insurance and Retail Trade sectors.

Employment and Gender:

- Of the 371 TCC female graduates, 77% were employed in the third quarter after graduation; 65% of the 220 male graduates were employed.
- For both females and males, those who majored in Health Professions & Related Programs had the highest employment rates (84% and 88%, respectively) in the third quarter after graduation.
- Nearly half (47%) of the 285 female graduates employed during the third quarter after graduation were working in the Health Care & Social Assistance (87) and Retail Trade (46) sectors; 35% of the 143 employed male graduates were working in the Retail Trade (35) and Finance & Insurance (15) sectors.
