Tunxis Credit Program Highlights

- Over 60 associate degrees & certificates
- New **Transfer Tickets** enable students to start with an associate degree from TCC and finish with a bachelor's degree from one of the CT State Universities or Charter Oak with no loss of credit.
- Tunxis is the recipient of a **\$4.2 million National Science Foundation grant** that established the College of Technology's Regional Center for Next Generation Manufacturing, a NSF Center of Excellence.
- **Transfer Programs** with UConn.
- **Accelerated online Business Administration** degree and certificate accredited by ACBSP.
- **The only college in CT selected by the U.S. Transportation Security Administration** to participate in a national TSA training program.
- Also the only public college in the state to provide a degree program in dental hygiene. *Additionally, the dental hygiene A.S. and dental assistant certificate are the only dental programs in the CSCU system accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation.*

CT CC students...69% are first-generation college students. Approx. two-thirds of African American and Hispanic undergraduates in public higher education in CT are enrolled at CCs.

Our Facilities...

Our conveniently-located main campus currently features a modern 20,000 square-foot Library, computer center, Veteran's OASIS, state-of-the-art dental lab, art and design studios, art gallery, NAEYC-accredited child care center, and more. Our satellite facility, Tunxis@ Bristol, is the result of collaboration among the College, city & businesses which enables Tunxis to expand educational and training opportunities and serve the community in new ways.

Phase II of the campus expansion was completed in 2013,

which expanded the Tunxis campus by 56,000 square feet, bringing total campus square footage to approximately 292,000. The three-story structure extends from the 600 Building and adds approximately 19 classrooms while easing the burden on some of the aging buildings on campus.

Meeting Industry Need, Contributing to a Competitive CT Workforce and Economy

- CT Community Colleges provide approx. 50% of health care workers in the state.
- CCs are the primary purveyors of training and opportunities for recently unemployed or under-employed workers.
- Educated citizens enjoy improved employment opportunities, contribute to the state's prosperity through higher taxes and reduce the state's costs for health care, unemployment, social services, and criminal justice.
- CT CC career program graduates report increased earnings of approx. \$11,500 six months after degree completion, resulting in over \$25 million additional annual taxable income for CT.
- Over 90% of CT Community College students are from CT and remain in CT, and approx. 40,000 live, work, pay taxes and contribute to the state's quality of life.
- Every \$1 invested in Community Colleges creates over \$8 in return in payroll, taxes, goods and services purchased.

Transfer Opportunities...

Many Connecticut Community College students transfer, continuing their studies at four-year colleges. Our transferable credits have enabled Tunxis students to pursue higher degrees at such institutions as University of Connecticut, CT State Universities, Trinity College, Yale University, Harvard University, Cornell University, University of Saint Joseph, Wesleyan University, Quinnipiac University, Georgetown University, Smith College, University of Notre Dame, Northeastern University, and Clark University.

Tunxis Helps Reduce the Critical Shortage of Health Care Workers in CT

Health care emphases include Dental Hygiene, Dental Assisting, Medical Transcription, Registered Medical Assistant (RMA), Certified Nurse Aide (CNA), Phlebotomy, Pharmacy Technician, Patient Care Technician, Central Sterile Processing Technician, EKG Technician, and Medical Billing & Coding Specialist. As of 2/17, the CNA program has graduated more than 2,000 individuals, and has had a nearly 100% employment rate.

Continuing Education...

Tunxis enrolls over 5,000 individuals each year in diverse non-credit and CEU programming. The College works closely with business and industry as well as with public and private agencies to ensure that instruction is tailored to individual and institutional needs. Continuing education programs are financially self-sustaining by participant or sponsor fees.

- Tunxis has provided customized on- and off-site training to over 40,000 employees in central Connecticut since 2000.
- Tunxis meets the changing needs of its communities and enhances workforce development opportunities for small- and medium-sized companies through such programs as Lean Manufacturing Training, Supervision Certificates, Electrician's License Renewal Training, Plumbers Continuing Education, Blueprint Reading, Website Development, and Customized Computer Training.
